BOARD MINUTES Rising Sun-Ohio County Community School Corporation September 7, 2017

A special session of the Board of School Trustees was held as advertised on September 7, 2017 at 11:00 A.M. in the administration building. The Superintendent presented the Teacher Appreciation Grants Policy as mandated per state code and to meet the September 15th deadline. In the past, the Teacher Performance Award was based on test scores benefiting more affluent school systems. The new process will award \$30 per student to be distributed to teachers rated as Effective and Highly Effective. The Highly Effective Teachers receiving a 25% higher stipend. If there is no interest, Mr. Roeder recommends that the items be declared junk.
