### **Week 3: Roll with it!**

*Materials:* Toilet paper roll, pencil, and scissors (construction paper/crayons/colored pencils/markers/paint if you have them)

I understand that many of you do not have a lot of Art supplies, so this lesson can easily be done with a pencil, scissors, and a toilet paper roll. If you do have access to other supplies, please use anything you have to be creative!

*Lesson: Octopus*

**You can make ANY animal you choose (additional ideas at the end of the lesson.) But if you can't get your creative juices pumping, make an Octopus.**

1. If you have paint or markers you can paint or color your toilet paper roll before cutting which is easier. You can also glue construction paper to it but you'll need to let it dry about 5 minutes before cutting.



2. An octopus has 6 arms and 2 legs (although they all seem like the same legs!) Make 8 cuts in one end of the roll. Try to measure them out so they are all the same width. Only cut half way up the roll to save room for the head/body.



3. Peel the legs up so that all legs will sit flat on a table/surface.



4. Draw a face.



5. Decorate its legs and body.
