January

April

May

- 1. Retake ECA if needed
- 2. Send graduation announcements
- 3. Notify the guidance office of post-graduation plans
- 4. Notify guidance office of any scholarships awarded to you
- 5. Attend senior breakfast, graduation practice, and awards day

June

- 1. Attend Graduation- dress appropriately (if you need shoes, ties, etc. let us know and we can help you)
